Instruction for Authors

J ELECTROCHEMISTRY (Chinese)

Electrochemistry is a journal published by the Chinese Chemical Society with its editorial board hosted by Xiamen University. The journal publishes paper on both fundamental and applied electrochemistry. We wish to provide an overview on the development and progress of electrochemistry contributed by Chinese colleagues mainly and also by foreign experts. The journal wishes to provide a forum for research work exchanging between Chinese and foreign colleagues. This journal is mainly published in Chinese but welcome to have some of the articles published in English submitted by foreign and Chinese authors. The journal publishes the articles in the forms of Reviews, Research Articles, Notes and Communications.

Type of Contributions

Reviews are summary of significant recent works and new developments from author's group and related works of other leading groups.

Research Articles and Notes are designed to report author's original results with experimental details. Both fundamental and technical articles are accepted.

Communications are restricted to publish some unusual and significant results with rapid processing. The author should briefly state the urgency of this paper in its cover letter.

Format of Contributions

The printed copies should be typed on A⁴ size paper in double space and with wide margins at least 3 cm in all sides. It should be printed on high quality paper and on one side of the pages only. Tables and figures as well as the legends should be appeared in separate sheets. The location of tables and figures in the text should be noticed.

Title of contributions should clearly and accurately indicates the contents of the paper and be expressed in adequate scientific terms.

Authors and Address. The name of the authors and addresses at which the research was done should be appeared under the title of the paper. Use the symbols a, b, c, etc., as superscripts to relate the authors to the corresponding address and an asterisk to indicate the author(s) to whom correspondence should be addressed. In order to speed up the processing of submitted contributions, authors should provide their telephone number, fax number and e-mail address for effective connection.

Abstract should be provided for all types of contributions in 200 words to state the purpose and main results as well as the conclusions of the reported work in brief. For Chinese authors, abstract in Chinese (ca. 350 characters) should be accompanied.

Keywords. 3~8 keywords or phrases should be provided to assist the readers to understand the topic of articles and to index this study in cross-indexing.

Tables should be used only in case the author wishes to present information effectively rather than running text. The title of tables should be located correctly above it.

Figures and Graphics including Photos should be prepared carefully for publication. Line drawings should be in a form suitable for direct reproduction. Standard symbols should be used in line drawings. The following are preferred: \triangle , \blacktriangle , \circ , \bullet , \square , \blacksquare , \odot , \oplus , \times . The width of all figures should be less than 14 cm and in the same degree of reduction.

Legends to figures and tables should be typed in sequence on a separate page or pages and be understanda-

ble without reference to the text. Quantity, unit and symbol should be used follow the regulation of SI unit.

References should be brought together at the end of the article and numbered in the order of their appearance in the text. Authors should check that all the references quoted in the text are appeared in the list of references and vice versa. The order of items in each reference should be as follows: for Periodicals, authors, title of paper, title of journal, year, volume and starting page number; for Books, authors, title of books, location of publisher, name of publisher, publishing year and pages. The listed number of authors in each reference is limited to three and the expression as "et al" could be used for the notice of remind authors.

Submission of Manuscripts

Manuscripts should be submitted by E-mail attachment in MS Word or PDF format. In case of the problems existing in received electronic files, 2 high quality printed copies via postal mail might be requested by the Editor. Mailing address and e-mail address, as well as telephone number and fax number of correspondence author should be noticed.

When a revision is requested, authors should answer the comments one by one in the cover letter and highlight the correction in the revised text with red pen. Authors should return the revised manuscript promptly.
